Who We Are, Where We Come From



The Numbers

YOUTHS 6,500 9,200 TOTAL FALL AND SPRING PARTICIPANTS

GVOLC fall and spring seasons have provided programming for more than 9,200 participants. Including 6,500 youth, 575 adults and over 2,100 underserved/low socioeconomic population. This summer we provided a 5 day camp experience for over 1,000 campers. This included 700 campers from Baltimore County, 100 campers from Southern Pennsylvania and 200 from Baltimore City. As an organization, we provided over \$7,000 in scholarships. Our calendar is full of new and returning schools, companies and non-profit organizations. The success of 40 years and growing is evident by the noise of people having fun, taking a risk jumping off a platform to ring a bell, or students communicating to get the group over the "croc pit". During the summer of 2020, GVOLC's summer camp followed COVID protocols and was able to serve over 800 campers. We were able to do this successfully and felt it was important to continue this in the fall and provide a safe environment for our community of working families. We offered an in-person learning experience for their children called, The Enrichment Program. This not only helped our community but it allowed the children to socialize, gain academic support and nurture their social emotional well being. This year more than ever the importance of socializing and reconnecting with peers has been extremely important. As we move into our upcoming season, our calendar is booking with schools, corporations and underserved youth ready to reconnect and start communicating.

Experiential Education

GVOLC's Experiential Education Program is the heart of all we do to help individuals and groups find their inner grit and grace to meet new challenges. The program utilizes our challenge course, one of the most extensive courses on the east coast, to actively focus on developing communication. cooperation. healthv risk-taking, leadership, trust. persistence and creative problem- solving skills. Individuals of all ages come to our outdoor learning center to engage in team-building and problem solving activities that utilize our low and high ropes course elements. Although fun is high on our priority

list, there is more to it than that; our facilitators 'debrief' participants after activities and use the course to discuss ways to meet everyday life head on. Participants grow through both verbal discussions and physical challenges that encourage them to step outside their comfort zone. Based on the goals of each group, GVOLC facilitators customize programs to meet their needs over half-day, full-day or week-long overnight experiences. GVOLC also offers off-site team building programs year-round. *GVOLC is an institutional member of The Association of Challenge Course Technology* and is a member of *Association for Experiential Education.*

Summer Camps

Our summer day camp offers campers ages 4 - 16 the opportunity to explore the outdoors, step out of their comfort zone, and build relationships with others. Our highly trained counselors work hard to foster a nurturing and safe environment for each camper. Activities range from archery, fishing to zipping and dipping into one of our lakes. Genesee Valley is accredited by *The American Camp Association.*

Sports Fields

With our 7 regulation and 3 youth sports fields (lacrosse, soccer), we are the home fields for our local recreation and club programs. GVOLC also utilizes these fields by renting them out to various tournament companies. These tournaments are showcasing events for future collegiate athletes. During one of these tournaments there can be over 6,000 spectators visiting our groomed fields. Genesee Valley hosts 5-6 of these events a year. Our commitment to provide high-quality, well maintained fields is part of our founder Tom LaMonica's legacy as a high school coach to hundreds of youth.
